Perched atop the highest hill in Macon, Georgia is located the Fort Hawkins Archaeological Park. Built in 1806, the fort overlooks the Ocmulgee Mounds National Historical Park, once known as the Ocmulgee Old Fields. The 1805 Treaty of Washington granted the United States the authority to construct the fort on Muscogee (Creek) land. After this treaty, the Ocmulgee River became the southwestern boundary of the United States.

Since the creation of Fort Hawkins, the property has had many uses including:
